1. Call to Order Chris

4. Budget/Finances Larry/Chandelle
  - a. Treasurer Larry Frick reported financial metrics from December 2025 accountant's report:
    - i. Total assets (STCU, WA Fed, BEW accounts): \$147,473.77
    - ii. Encumbered funds: \$ 9,000 Resident request  
\$77,955.02 WA Fed CD  
\$15,000 – Innovia grant for picnic shelter  
Total: \$101,955.02
    - iii. Available operating funds: \$45,518.75
5. Malden Town Council Report Bob
  - a. New Mayor and Council establishing rapport
  - b. There is one new Council member; there is still one Council seat available
  - c. Spring installation of picnic shelter will occur upon completion of the approval of the site plan, letter of support from Malden and associated permit.
  - d. SCJ Alliance will present an updated plan for the town of Malden at the next Council meeting on February 11<sup>th</sup>

- a. Council on Aging/Human Services/COAST Transportation has closed; Aging and Long-Term Care in Eastern Washington (ALTCEW) is coordinating who will provide COA's services (food banks, congregate meals, kinship programs and transportation)**
- b. Malden Food Bank**
  - i. With closing of COA, there are no food deliveries from Colfax; COA vans have been repossessed**
  - ii. Malden food bank has \$13,000 in a COA account; Chris will contact ALTCEW to access these funds, and discuss the future coordination of area food banks**
  - iii. Bob made 22 trips since November 2025 for food to stock the food bank; there is enough food for the next few food bank days of operation**

    - a) Innovia \$2,500 – \$15,000 Community Grant  
2026 FUNDING THEME: Building Stability and Belonging; PCCRLTRO will apply for operating funds to continue to build community engagement; Application Cycle Closes: February 6, 2026**
    - b) Addium-METER: Typical awards range from \$1,000 - \$7,500; must include 80 to 400 hours of skilled volunteer assistance from Addium-METER employees; Deadline is February 13, 2026, Notification of awards made April 2026; PCCRLTRO will apply for Malden Park Beautification project (flowers, trees (Tree City), shrubs)**
    - c) Ben and Jerry's Social Justice, Costco Community Grant are available on a rolling proposal basis**
- b. Chandelle will send a condolences card to John Goyke on behalf of the PCCRLTRO for the passing of his brother Mark on January 5<sup>th</sup>**
- c. Chris will invite Mayor Totten to the next PCCRLTRO meeting to discuss goals**
- d. February 18<sup>th</sup> meeting will focus on PCCRLTRO goal setting in coordination with goals for the towns of Malden and Pine City**
